PROCEDURE: ABDOMEN/PELVIS W/O CON. 74176

HISTORY: ASCITES, INFLAMMATORY LIVER DISEASE, SOB

No prior comparison.

Technique: Multiple contiguous axial images of the abdomen and pelvis with sagittal and coronal reconstructions. Images are acquired without contrast.

The liver is lobular in contour, the appearance suggesting cirrhosis. The spleen is abnormally enlarged, measuring up to 20.1 cm in greatest dimension. Cholelithiasis is noted. There is suspected Gallbladder wall thickening. Correlate with clinical findings. There are suspected splenic venous varicosities. Perihepatic ascites is noted. Mural thickening is seen in the ascending and transverse colon, which may reflect colitis. Correlate with clinical information. No bowel obstruction is seen. There is a large, complex, predominantly cystic left adnexal mass which measures 8.5 x 10.8 x 10.3 cm. This is nonspecific, but neoplasm must be excluded. The presence of ascites is concerning for possible ovarian cancer with metastatic disease. No bulky mesenteric masses are visualized.

No renal calculi are seen. There is no renal obstruction. The ureters are normal in course and caliber. The urinary bladder is not well-defined, relative to the left adnexal lesion, in the absence of contrast. No adrenal mass is seen. There is no abdominal aortic aneurysm. No free air is seen.

Impression:

1. Cirrhotic appearance of the liver.
2. Splenomegaly.
3. Cholelithiasis, with gallbladder wall thickening, suggesting possible acute cholecystitis. Correlate with clinical information.
4. Complex, predominantly cystic left adnexal mass. Neoplasm must be excluded. Differentiation from the bladder is not distended on the present study, without contrast.
5. Ascites.
6. Mural thickening involving the ascending and transverse colon likely reflects colitis. Correlate with clinical information.
