Comparison with 3-23-16.

Findings: The cardiac silhouette and pulmonary vasculature are within normal limits. There is appears to be chronic elevation of the anterior right hemidiaphragm, but this is more prominent than on previous radiographs dated 12-29-14. Correlation with chest CT is recommended to better characterize. No infiltrate or pleural effusion is currently seen. no pneumothorax is seen. No acute osseous abnormality is visualized.

Impression:

1. Rounded density at the anterior aspect of the right hemithorax, which may reflect eventration of the diaphragm, but this has become more prominent since previous radiographs dated 12-29-14, and chest CT is therefore recommended in order to better characterize.
2. No infiltrate, or pleural effusion is currently seen.
